IPRATE rates intellectual-property firms and attorneys in 32 European countries. Every rating is computed from 21,262,773 official filing and outcome records held at EUIPO, the EPO and the national IP offices; there are no surveys, no submissions and no paid listings, and a rating cannot be bought. IPRATE is operated by Socialiniai algoritmai, UAB (Vilnius, Lithuania), company code 304068578.

How the ratings work

Ratings are computed per country, practice area, filing track and time window from official filing and outcome records. Six pillars: experience, initial success, relative efficiency, asset durability, renewal survival and local applicant share. Small samples are shrunk toward the cohort median, so a handful of favourable cases cannot create a top rating. Tiers, lowest to highest: Select, Proven, Leading, Elite. Every published rating carries a confidence grade of A, B or C; grade D is never published.

What may be quoted

Individual ratings may be quoted with attribution ("Source: IPRATE, iprate.eu"). Bulk reuse of tables and datasets requires prior written authorisation. A rated firm may display its own tier badge; a badge does not imply endorsement of anything else.
